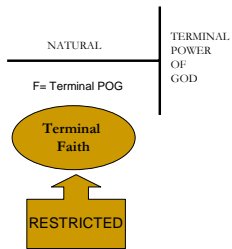

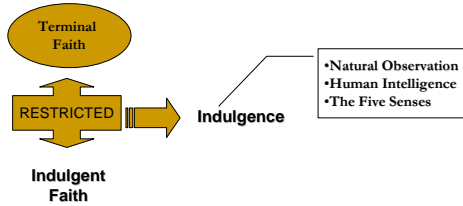

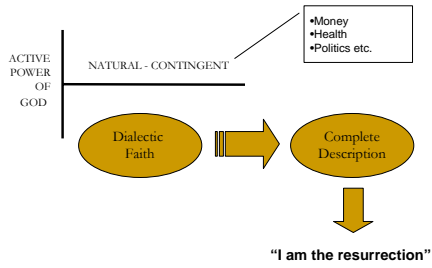
Dialective Faith

 - The Queen of the south

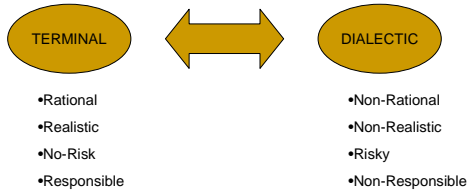
Incomplete Description of The Situation



Complete Description of The Situation



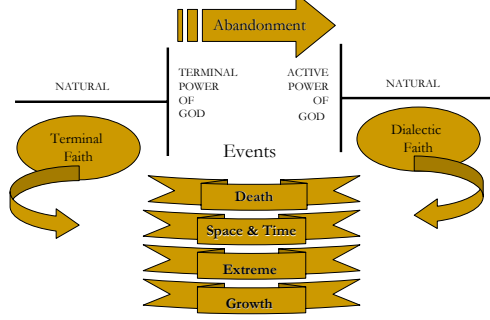
Terminal vs. Dialectic
